**Moriel** was born in Jerusalem, raised in Yellow Springs, Ohio, and graduated from Middlebury College with a degree in Arabic and Political Science. He moved back to Jerusalem in 2011, and has been involved with a number of nonviolent campaigns and groups working against the occupation, including the [All That's Left](#) anti-occupation collective, and an independent group of [Jerusalem activists](#). In 2012, Moriel spent time in Israeli military jail for [refusing](#) to enlist in the Israeli army. Moriel has worked with groups including [Rabbis for Human Rights](#) and [Just Vision](#), and is currently an independent writer, public speaker, unofficial tour guide, official poet and activist.
